Statement of Commitment to Child Safety

Clarendon Children's Centre is committed to respecting and protecting every child's rights, as expressed in the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child.

In particular we commit to upholding each child's rights to quality education and care, and to feel, and to be, safe.

We recognise the importance of our role in a child's life, to respond, record and report incidents, disclosures or suspicions regarding child abuse or misconduct.

Our first priority is to ensure the welfare of the children in our care and we have zero tolerance for any act of child abuse or discrimination.

We are committed to maintaining a service that supports children's best interests and that actively works to listen to, and empower, all children.

Our aim is to take deliberate steps to protect children from physical, sexual, emotional, psychological and cultural abuse, and neglect.

We commit to:

- Supporting early disclosures of abuse.
- Ensuring the accountability of adults.
- Challenging unacceptable behaviours.
